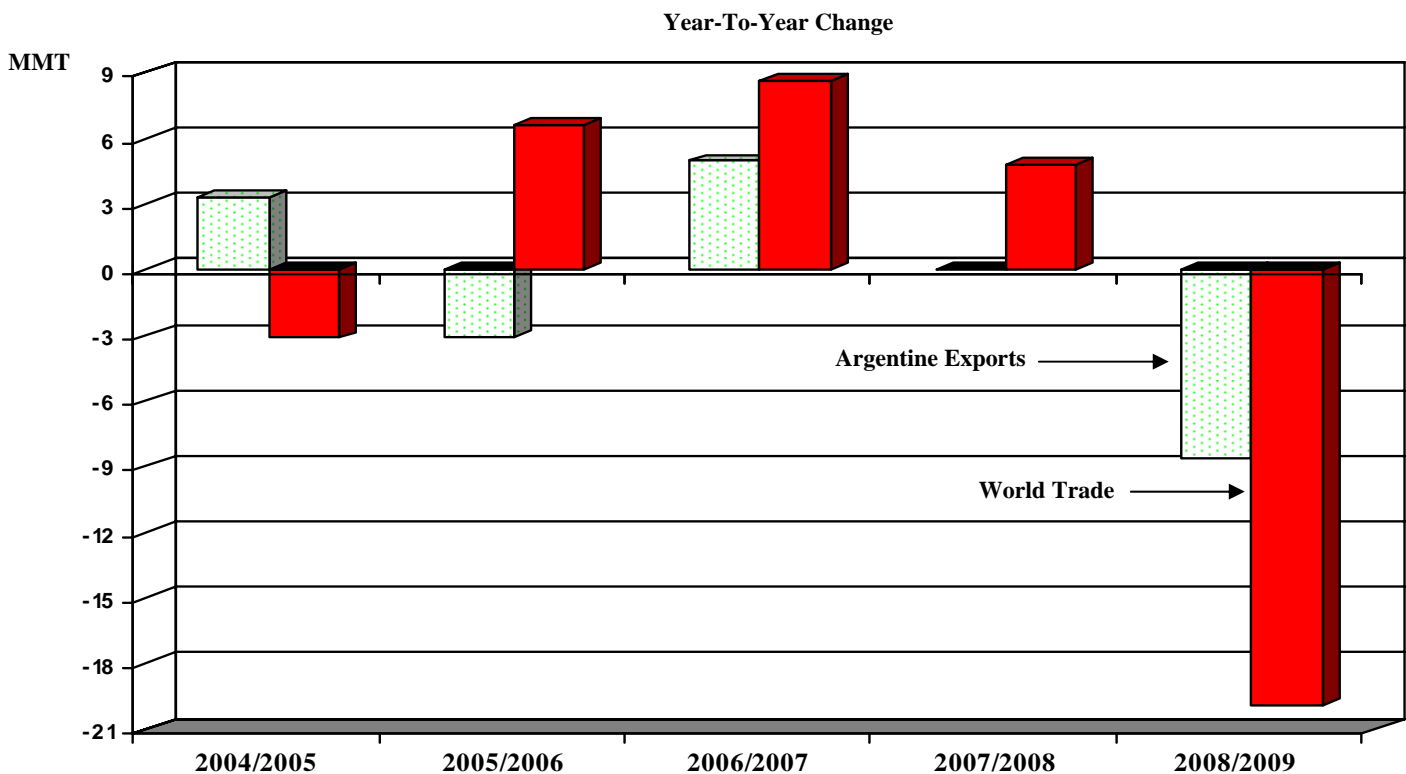




Grain: World Markets and Trade

Shrinking Corn Supplies in Argentina Further Slow World Exports



At the same time as Argentina's exportable supplies of corn have shrunk due to drought, world import demand is down sharply as a result of economic turmoil, and feed demand has shifted to other competitively priced substitutes including feed-quality wheat, cassava, and Distillers Dried Grains (DDGS).

Argentina's government has yet to open export registrations. However, once those registrations are opened, we would expect the tight new-crop supplies to be sold only to traditional and nearby markets. We would also expect Argentina's North African and Mediterranean markets to be aggressively sought-after by Brazil, Ukraine, and the EU.

The United States may be poised to meet some of Argentina's shortfall, as evidenced by recent strong corn export sales.

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The Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) updates its production, supply and distribution database for cotton, oilseeds, and grains at 9 a.m. on the day the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report is released. It is available on the FAS website (<http://www.fas.usda.gov/psdonline/>). This circular is released at 9:30 a.m. on the same day, together with its downloadable data set.

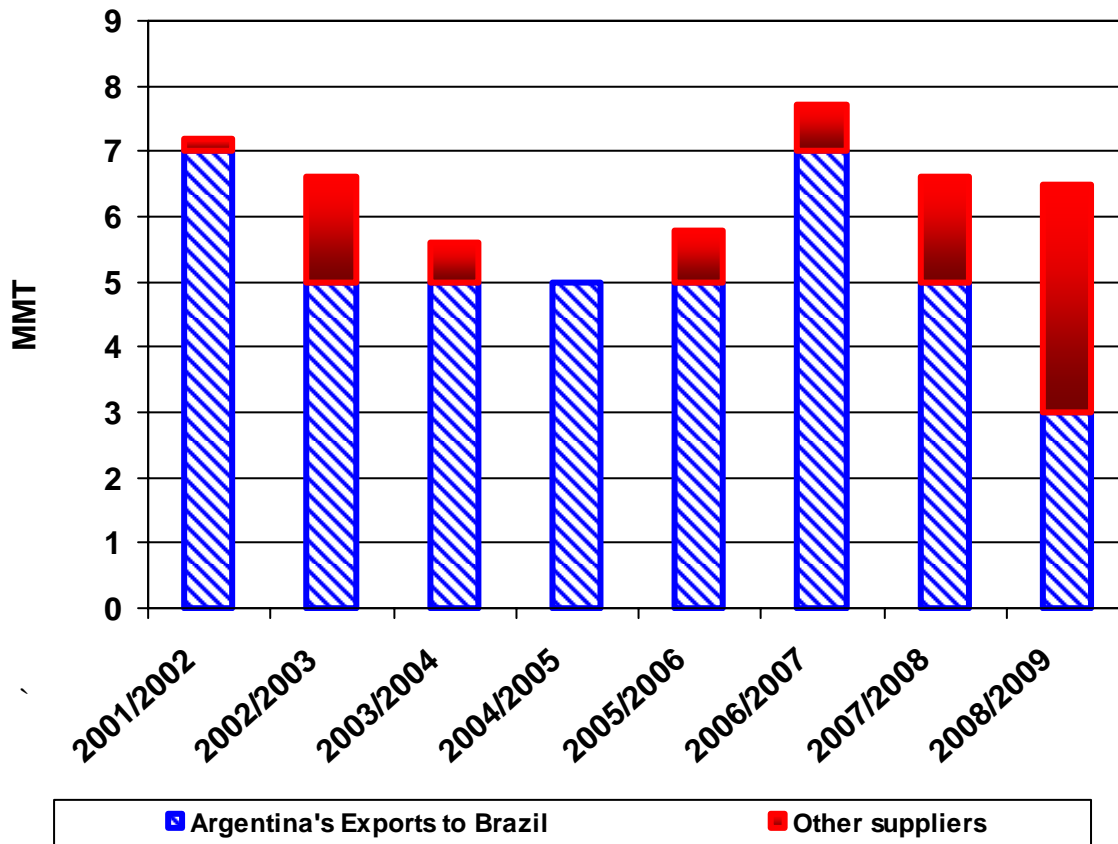

Brazil Needs Wheat as Argentina's Supplies Decline

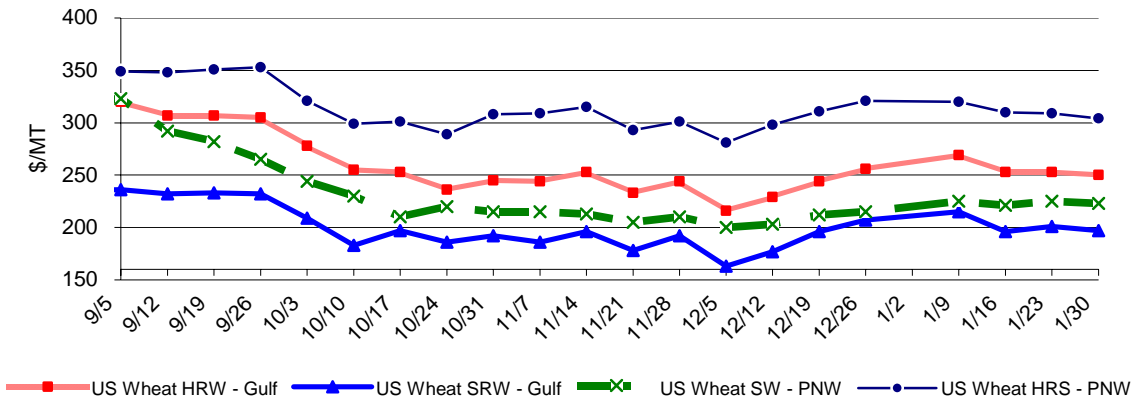


There are unusually large opportunities for other exporters to sell wheat to Brazil because of Argentina's limited supplies. Brazil is one of the world's largest buyers, importing 5 to 8 million tons a year. Argentina usually supplies close to 90 percent of Brazil's needs, but last year Brazil was forced to look to other suppliers due to the temporary closing of Argentina's export registrations. Exports are restricted again this year due to Argentina's drought-reduced crop. Consequently, Brazil will need to look outside its regional trade partners again this year to meet its needs.

Similar to last year, the United States and Canada are likely beneficiaries of Argentina's shortfall in the Brazilian market. Both countries have an abundance of exportable supplies and competition between them is likely to intensify in the coming months as old-crop wheat will continue to weigh on the market.

PRICES:

Domestic: Prices for most wheat classes declined modestly during January, with the exception of Soft White (SWW). Hard Red Spring (HRS) fell \$18 to \$304/ton, Hard Red Winter (HRW) declined \$12 to \$250/ton, Soft Red Winter (SRW) prices fell \$15 to \$197/ton, and SWW increased \$11 to \$223/ton.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2008/2009

Selected Exporters

- **Ukraine** is up 500,000 tons to a record 9.5 million, due to continued forward sales, particularly of feed-quality wheat.
- **Turkey** is raised 500,000 tons to 1.8 million based on the increased pace of flour exports.
- **China** is cut 500,000 tons to 1.5 million due to a drop-off in wheat grain exports.
- **Brazil exports** are reduced 400,000 tons to 800,000 due to slow pace of exports and **imports** are cut 500,000 tons to 6.5 million as larger supplies are available to the domestic market.

Selected Importers

- **Iran** is raised 1.0 million tons to 5.5 million based on the strong pace of shipments and continued purchases.
- **Pakistan** is raised 300,000 tons to 2.8 million based on recent tenders.

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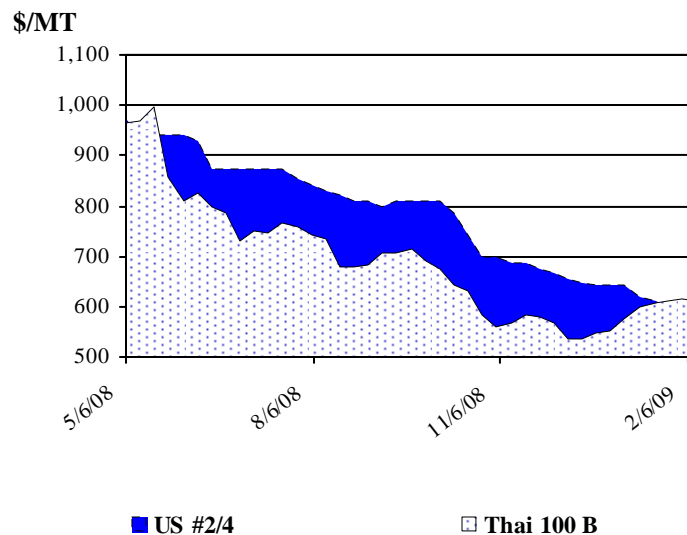

RICE: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

PRICES

U.S. and Thai quotes are together again, after a peak gap of \$155 since their last convergence in April 2008. The convergence, however, is somewhat artificial, as recent Thai quotes are a reflection of the above market prices the Thai government is offering under its intervention program. Little new 100 B is being exported at these high prices, as foreign buyers are turning to more competitive rice in Vietnam, Pakistan, and Burma.

SELECTED TRADE CHANGES FOR 2009

- **Burmese** exports are raised 300,000 tons to 500,000 based on additional shipments to nearby Asian and West African countries.
- **Thai** exports are lowered 500,000 tons to 9.0 million due to increased competition from Vietnam.
- **Indian** exports are up 200,000 tons to 2.5 million based on expectations of larger shipments in the second half of the year.
- **Liberian** imports are more than doubled to 200,000 tons on recent purchasing trends.
- **Philippine** imports are down 500,000 tons to 2.0 million on large carryover supplies from last year's record production and record imports.

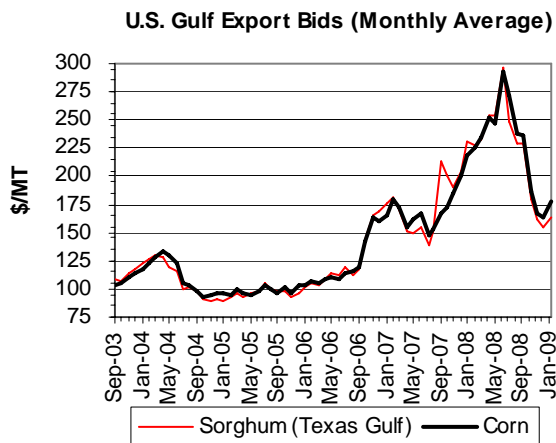

COARSE GRAINS: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

PRICES:

Domestic: U.S. export corn prices averaged \$177 per ton during January compared with \$163 in December. Continued uncertainty over Southern Hemisphere production and 3 weeks of million-tons-plus U.S. export sales supported prices. Sorghum prices averaged \$164 during January compared with \$154 per ton the prior month.



TRADE CHANGES IN 2008/09

Selected Exporters

- **Argentine corn** is slashed again this month, by 2.0 million tons, to 7.0 million on lower expected supplies due to drought. This is the lowest export level in 13 years.
- **Paraguayan corn** is lowered by 500,000 tons on a major cut in production.
- **Russian corn** is boosted by 200,000 tons to 500,000, the highest in over 20 years, on indications of brisk trade.
- **Ukrainian corn** is raised 500,000 tons to a record 4.0 million with record exportable supplies.
- **Argentine barley** is lowered 200,000 tons to 750,000 based on slow demand.
- **Australian barley** is up 500,000 tons to 3.5 million based on larger exportable supplies.
- **EU barley** is reduced 500,000 tons to 4.0 million based on strong competition from Ukraine and Russia.
- **Australian sorghum** is raised 400,000 tons to 850,000, the highest in 8 years, on a larger crop and expectations of greater shipments to Japan.

Selected Importers

- **Mexican corn** is down 500,000 tons to 7.5 million on slow purchases from the United States. At the same time, **Mexican sorghum** is raised 300,000 tons again this month to 2.3 million on strong U.S. shipments and sales.
- **South Korea corn** is down 700,000 tons to 6.5 million, the lowest in over 15 years, because of a slow pace of sales and shipments from the United States and continued interest from feed manufacturers in non-grain feed ingredients.

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- **Iranian barley** is raised 500,000 tons to a record 1.7 million based on strong early-season export shipment information.
 - **Moroccan barley** is halved to 500,000 tons on improved new-crop production prospects and slower-than-expected purchases from the EU.

OTHER NOTES

Local Marketing Years (LMY): LMY refers to the 12-month period following the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's LMY for that commodity (2008/09 starts in 2008); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the LMY (2008/09 starts in 2009). Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

Trade: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year.

EU Consolidation: The trade figures starting from 1999/00 represent EU-27 and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria and Romania, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat, flour, and selected pasta products on a grain equivalent basis. (2) Rice trade statistics include rough, brown, milled, and broken on a milled

equivalent basis. (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
