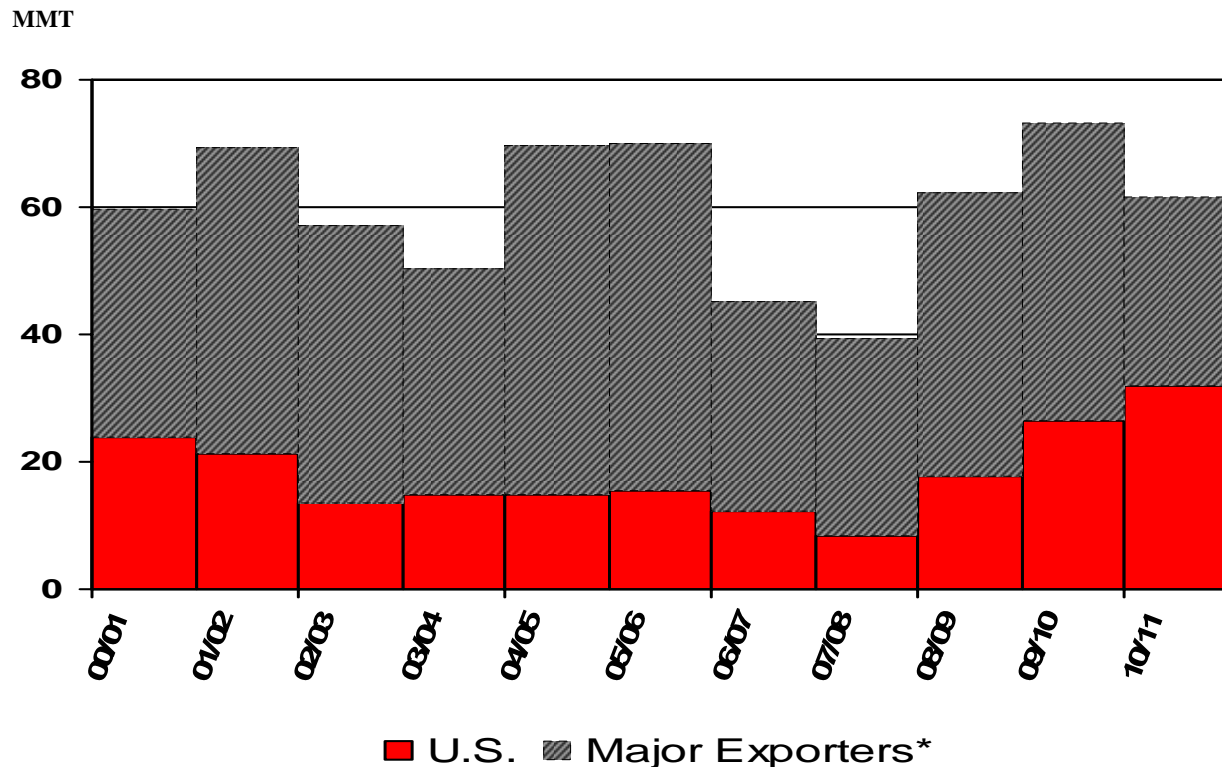




Grain: World Markets and Trade

Exporter Wheat Ending Stocks Shrink

Exporter stocks of wheat are now forecast to drop year-to-year by 12 MMT (16%), whereas, just a few months ago, these stocks were forecast to expand modestly. Deteriorating crop prospects in several major exporting countries, particularly Canada, Kazakhstan, and Russia, along with strong global import demand, have contributed to that reversal. Tightening supplies are already causing prices in the United States and the EU to rise. However, the drawdown of exporter stocks is expected to partially mitigate the current production shortfall.

The United States is the exception, with expansion currently forecast in production, exports and ending stocks. As supplies for high protein wheat shrink in other exporting countries, the United States is well positioned to take advantage of any further tightening of supplies and/or stronger global import demand.

With planting just getting underway, the Southern Hemisphere producers, Australia and Argentina, are the wildcards in the supply picture since they typically hold relatively little stocks.

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The Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) updates its production, supply and distribution database for cotton, oilseeds, and grains at 9 a.m. on the day the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report is released. It is available on the FAS website (<http://www.fas.usda.gov/psdonline/>). This circular is released at 10:00 a.m. on the same day, together with its downloadable data set.

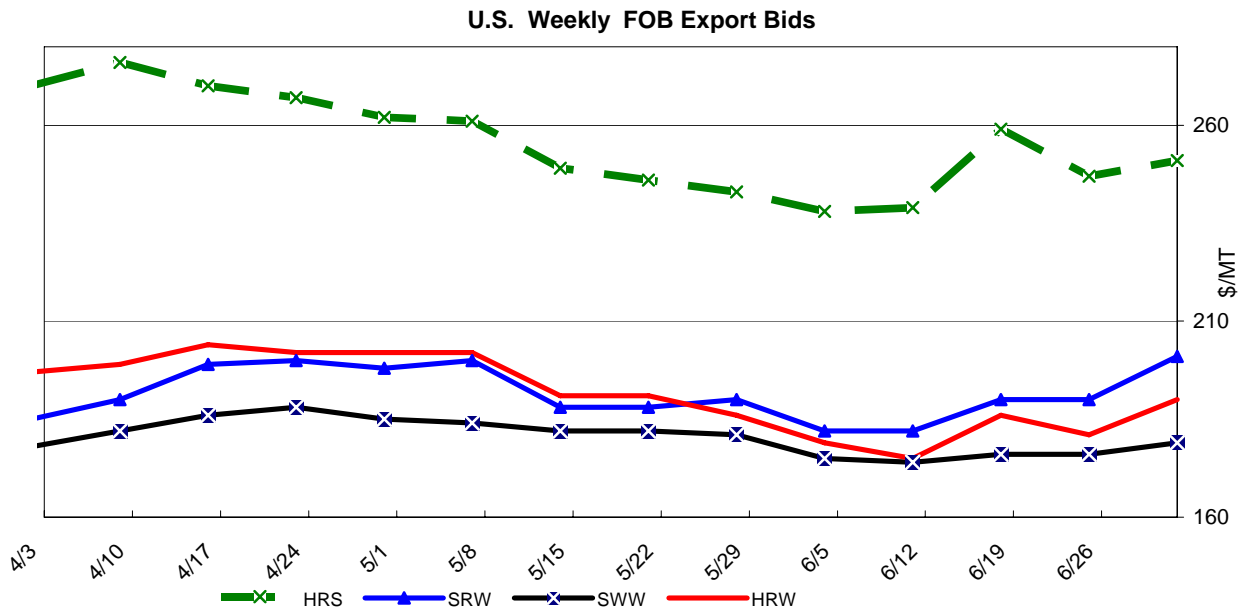

WHEAT: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE



PRICES:

Domestic prices: Prices of all classes of wheat rose in June with expanding export prospects. We note the divergence between cheaper Hard Red Winter (HRW), up \$11/ton to \$190, and Soft Red Winter (SRW) up \$19/ton to \$201, due to shrinking domestic and global supplies. Hard Red Spring (HRS) jumped \$13/ton to \$251 and Soft White Wheat (SWW) increased marginally to \$179/ton, a \$4 gain.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2010/11

Selected Exporters

- **Australia** is up 1.0 million tons to 15.0 million on shrinking exportable supplies in most other competitors.
- **Canada** is lowered sharply by 2.0 million tons to 15.5 million on lower production prospects due to reduced planted area.
- **EU** is raised 1.0 million tons to 23.0 million as the Black Sea exportable surplus falls.
- **Kazakhstan** is reduced 500,000 tons to 8.0 million on drought reduced yields.

- **Russia** is slashed 2.5 million tons to 15.0 million due to substantially lower crop prospects and growing domestic feed demand.
 - **Turkey** is down 300,000 tons to 3.1 million on reduced crop prospects.
 - **Ukraine** is up 500,000 tons to 8.0 million on less competition from Russia.
 - **United States** is boosted 2.5 million tons to 27.0 million based on less exportable supplies in most major exporting countries.

Selected Importers

- **Turkey** is raised 200,000 tons to 3.5 million on tighter domestic supplies and reduced crop prospects.
- **United States** is cut 300,000 tons to 2.7 million due to tighter supplies of Canadian high protein wheat.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2009/10

Selected Exporters

- **Canada** is raised 500,000 tons to 18.5 million on a higher pace of shipments.
- **The United States** is down 400,000 tons to 23.6 million based on recent Census trade data.

Selected Importers

- **EU** is reduced 500,000 tons to 5.5 million based on recent import license data and the slow pace of imports.

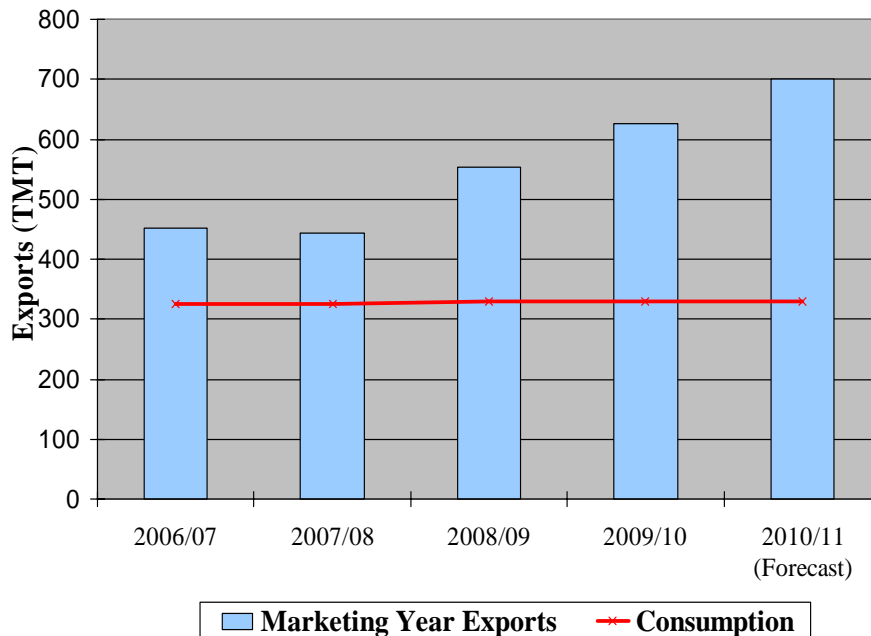

RICE: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

Argentina's Exports Expand as Consumption Remains Flat



Argentina's exports have jumped by a third in just 5 years as a result of expanding production caused by high international prices, large import demand from Brazil, and few export restrictions. With plenty of water for irrigation, high quality land, and investment in infrastructure, the rice industry is optimistic about its future.

Argentina's logistical advantage and the preferential tariff treatment under Mercosur have helped expand sales to Brazil and Chile. However, as exportable supplies continue to grow, new markets will be needed. Currently, the industry is looking to strengthen trade with the Middle East and Venezuela.

In a culture where wheat products are preferred, Argentines consume over ten times more wheat than rice per capita, and there is nothing to indicate that this is likely to change.

SELECTED TRADE CHANGES

Egypt's 2011 exports were dropped 100,000 tons to 300,000 on government efforts to lower production in order to save water. Imports were raised 115,000 tons to a record 150,000 to make up for some of the lost production. In contrast, 2010 exports increased 80,000 tons to 600,000 on the pace to date.

Iran's imports for 2011 and 2010 were each dropped 100,000 tons to 1.5 million and 1.3 million, respectively, on newly available data. Imports for 2009 were bumped 70,000 tons to 1.5 million for the same reason.

Libya's 2011 imports were raised 60,000 tons to 100,000 following a tripling of 2010 imports to 150,000 based on large sales from Egypt. Year-to-year purchases are expected to drop as Egypt withdraws from the market.

MARKETING YEAR CHANGE

The marketing year for Paraguay has been changed to better reflect the country's natural production and marketing cycle. The definition was changed beginning with 2007/2008:

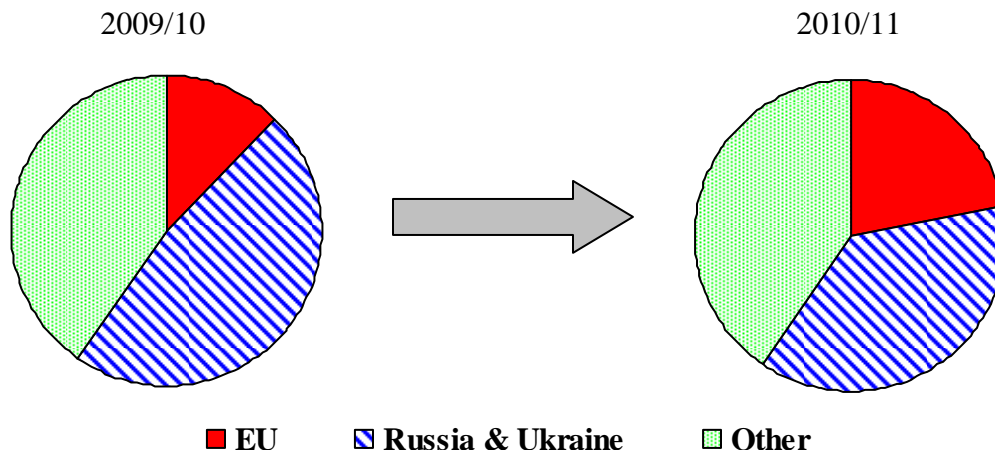

COARSE GRAINS: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

Barley: EU Exports Rebound on Shrinking Global Supplies



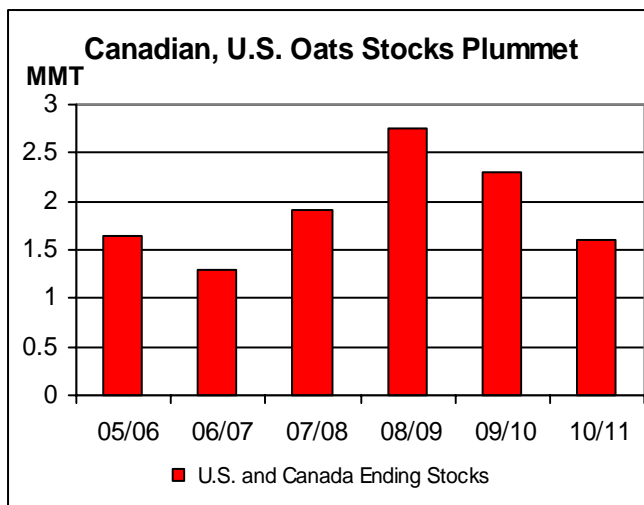
What a difference a year makes – at least for barley in the EU. Just a year ago, the EU was losing market share from low-cost regional suppliers (Russia and Ukraine), and from Canada with its single-desk marketing system, while EU barley moved into intervention. This year, EU barley is expected to be more competitive, as intervention is no longer available as a marketing option.

Weather-related events can dramatically alter the global trade picture for virtually any commodity, and barley is no exception, particularly when there are only a few surplus producers. The dichotomy of flooding in Canada and drought in Russia has resulted in sharply reduced production prospects, while pressure to meet domestic needs, particularly for feed, are also expected to limit supplies available for export.

The EU is holding nearly 6 million tons of intervention stocks, which could either be released later in the season to keep internal prices “reasonable,” or could be made available to meet expanding exports.

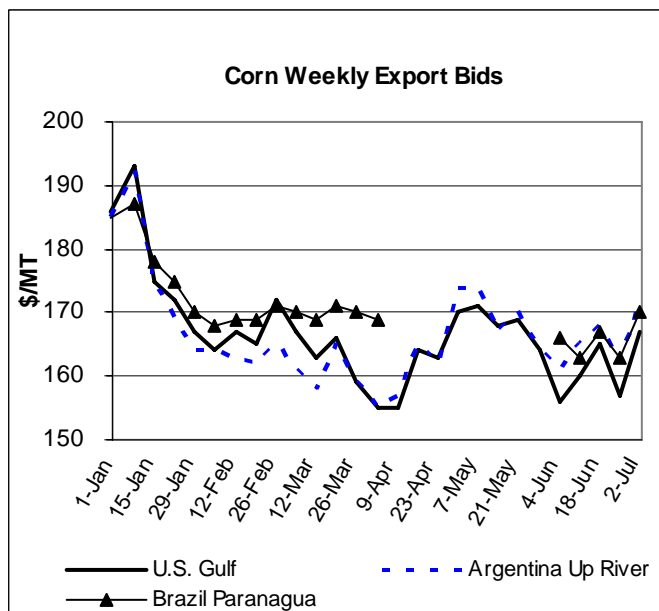
MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT:

Oats supplies in the **United States** and **Canada** are expected to fall dramatically on rain-reduced plantings in Canada. U.S. oats imports are expected to fall 100,000 tons to 1.6 million, as lower Canadian exports are only partially offset by larger **EU** exports.



PRICES:

Domestic: From June through early July, U.S. corn export prices whipsawed \$15/ton, ending up sharply at \$165. Markets reacted to favorable early-season crop conditions and additional sales to China. Then, on June 30, lower-than-expected acreage and June 1 stocks reported by USDA caused an immediate surge in prices. Although all three corn exporters' prices are moving in tandem, U.S. prices remain at a consistent discount to Argentine and Brazilian prices on a FOB-to-FOB basis.



TRADE CHANGES IN 2010/11

Selected Exporters

- **U.S. corn** is cut 1.5 million tons to 49.5 million because of reduced crop prospects and lower carryin stocks following the release of USDA's *Acreage* and *Grain Stocks* reports.

-
- **Brazilian and Ukrainian corn** are each raised 500,000 tons to 8.0 million and 6.0 million, respectively, due to ample supplies and reduced competition from the United States.
 - **Australian barley** is raised 300,000 tons to 3.6 million on reduced competitor supplies, particularly in Canada and Russia.
 - **Canadian barley** is lowered 400,000 tons to 1.0 million, the lowest in 8 years, as domestic feed needs and reduced crop prospects will likely limit exports.
 - **EU barley** jumps 1.4 million tons to 3.6 million as reduced exportable supplies in competitor countries, combined with large carry-over stocks, provide greater export opportunities.
 - **Russian barley** is lowered 800,000 tons to 1.0 million, the smallest in 10 years, on sharply reduced crop prospects.

Selected Importers

- **Mexican corn** is down 500,000 tons to 9.1 million due to ample domestic stocks.
- **Chinese barley** is raised 400,000 tons to 1.9 million on expectations of greater domestic malt use (similarly, 2009/10 imports are raised 300,000 tons to 1.9 million).

TRADE CHANGES IN 2009/10

Selected Exporters

- **Canadian barley** is lowered 200,000 tons to 1.2 million on slower exports and expectations of tight new-crop supplies.
- **EU barley** is raised 600,000 tons to 2.1 million on the unusually strong pace of export licenses during the month of June.

Selected Importers

- **South Korean corn** imports are boosted 400,000 tons to 8.2 million based on brisk shipments from the United States.
- **Syrian barley** is lowered 200,000 tons to 500,000 on expectations of a rebound in production in 2010.

OTHER NOTES

Local Marketing Years (LMY): LMY refers to the 12-month period following the main harvest, when the crop is marketed (i.e., consumed, traded, or stored). The year first listed begins a country's LMY for that commodity (2008/09 starts in 2008); except for summer grains in certain Southern Hemisphere countries and for rice in selected countries, where the second year begins the LMY (2008/09 starts in 2009). Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

Trade: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year.

EU Consolidation: The trade figures starting from 1999/00 represent EU-27 and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria and Romania, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat, flour, and selected pasta products on a grain equivalent basis. (2) Rice trade statistics include rough, brown, milled, and broken on a milled

equivalent basis. (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
